Andy,

My two questions are:

1) can you please review the attached and advise ANY details in my summary that may not accurately reflect actions/intentions by our Agency as presented in the emails you sent and received? Please also forward to Mr. Ferrington to get his response.

2) please also advise, in accordance with the forced settlement at MSPB that you signed, how will you be assisting if and when I need your participation in searching for future employment? I ask this because, frankly, your email response history suggests you have been directed to ignore my communications, thus you will do nothing, causing further damages to me.

I have cc'd copies to Deplasco, Foushee, and Robinson.


Mark: please respond to question #1 above, as you, too, would know the actions and intentions of our Agency related to both the pressure to get Switaj to retire, and the pressure to fire me (with subsequent forced settlement).

Clay: you need to be aware of these details as they relate to your role, as FAA's man in charge of managing whistleblower cases...and ensuring our Agency is steering clear of retaliatory practices. Please advise what other records you need to see to assist Mr. Richards and Mr. Deplasco - and our Agency - to clean up this mess. Also, can you advise, is Mr. Grizzle aware of any of the details of this case?

Andrew: I share this with you as you were a witness from February 2007, and thus apply these details to assess the possible misuse of the Accountability Board program. Please forward to the AB Director and other relevant personnel.
