JEFF - First off, let me apologize for the delay in responding to this and your letter dated June 12, 2007. I have been doing a lot of traveling, and in fact I will be out of the office again beginning tomorrow, July 16 and will not be returning until Tuesday, July 31. I will address the issues you raise below, as they are essentially the same as the issues you raised in your June 12th letter.

1) On all about 4/17/07, Mr. Ralph notified you that you were being removed from an administrative leave status due to the fact that you were medically incapacitated and had not provided the requisite medical documentation to determine your qualification for duty. In that letter, Mr. Ralph asked you what type of leave you would want to be placed on and that if you failed to respond you would be placed on sick leave until further notice. You responded in an e:mail to Mr. Ralph on April 27, 2007, wherein you stated you wanted to continue being carried on administrative leave. Since this was not an option that Mr. Ralph offered to you in his April 17 letter, he placed you on sick leave.

2) As for the "periodic feedback" of your Accountability Board investigation, it is my understanding that Mr. Ralph has attempted to contact you telephonically in the past, most recently within the last week. The information I have received is that you were not cooperative and did not want to hear the feedback that Mr. Ralph had for you. In the very near future, Mr. Ralph, or another management official in the ATO organization will be contacting you to provide the feedback.

3) Pursuant to security regulations, you are not entitled to a copy of the Report of Investigations (ROI) unless some action is proposed for you. As of this point, there has been no proposed action, and you are therefore not entitled to a copy of the ROI. It is my understanding that this information was passed on to several months ago, and that time, the security personnel suggested that you put your request in writing.

I hope this addresses your concerns.
