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Andy:

Thanks for the email confirmation, and looking forward to your call today.

I have spent nearly a week considering the "disability retirement" as you suggested in your call last week. I have spent a few hours researching the FERS disability rules, and communicated with Shawna Richard at AWP HR. While I cannot make a prudent decision without solid information (which still is not available), I have also concluded the decision is not necessary as, frankly, I am not ethically allowed to "choose" a disability retirement...as I lack a disability. Therefore, I request you please do the following:

1. restore my pay status, retroactively, and if you still have no work for me now, place me into a paid administrative leave status;
2. follow through on the comment you made in the last phone call by arranging an FAA-paid medical evaluation with the unspecified doctor in Marin County; note, in accord with the Contract, I should be properly notified in writing of the "presenting concern" and appointment details, in a confidential letter from Aerospace Medicine...NOT from Jason Ralph or Air Traffic;
3. confirm FAA legal counsel has verified the legality of my present pay status without notification;
4. advise the status of the grievance we discussed.
