MOTION

Defendants Federal Aviation Administration and Administrator Michael Huerta, by S. Amanda Marshall, United States Attorney for the District of Oregon, through Assistant U.S. Attorney Kevin Danielson, and Plaintiff Jeffrey Lewis, who is pro se, move this Court to extend the scheduling order by 60-days for the following reasons:

1. This action was brought under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552. Plaintiff alleged that Defendant unlawfully failed to respond to approximately 14 FOIA requests.
2. Currently, dispositive motions are due by May 20, 2014.
3. Defendant has produced approximately 2,100 pages of documents to Plaintiff.
4. On two separate dates, Counsel for Defendant and Mr. Lewis have met and spent a total of nine hours reviewing the documents and the exemptions claimed by Defendant.
5. The parties are attempting to resolve as many disputes as possible regarding the search and the FOIA exemptions claimed by Defendant in order to narrow the issues for the Court.
6. The parties require additional time to work on the matter before filing dispositive motions.
7. The parties are requesting the scheduling order be modified as follows:
 - A. All dispositive motions are due by July 21, 2014.
 - B. Responses and replies are due based on the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.
 - C. Oral Argument to be set at a later time.

CONCLUSION

Defendants request that the scheduling order be modified as set forth above.
