Plaintiff moves this Court to schedule a limited oral argument, focusing on two disputed FAA records. Plaintiff believes these two records are the two most disputed within this civil action. Plaintiff also believes that limited oral argument might enable both parties to substantially narrow the scope of the disputed portions of this civil action.

The two disputed FAA records proposed for this limited oral argument include:

1. the ATSAP Report related to the July 25, 2010 controller error at the FAA control tower at Camarillo, CA. This record is identified within Defendant FAA's Vaughn Index as pages FAA-1673-A through FAA-1674-A. Dkt. 28-1, pg. 32
2. the Report of Investigation (ROI), dated March 4, 2007 and created after a swastika incident (and other improper actions) at the SeaTac TRACON. This record is identified within Defendant FAA's Vaughn Index as pages FAA-1560-A1 through FAA-1560-A86. Dkt. 28-1, pg. 30-31

Plaintiff makes this motion as a proposal to expeditiously and more efficiently resolve the matter at hand.

Plaintiff continues to maintain his objections to all other disputed FAA records. However, Plaintiff hopes that the proposed oral argument will produce a resolution with at least limited records disclosure, which if sufficient will enable Plaintiff to justly withdraw all other objections.


